



## Festival of Arts 2011 Artwork Submission Guidelines Digital Submission Preparation



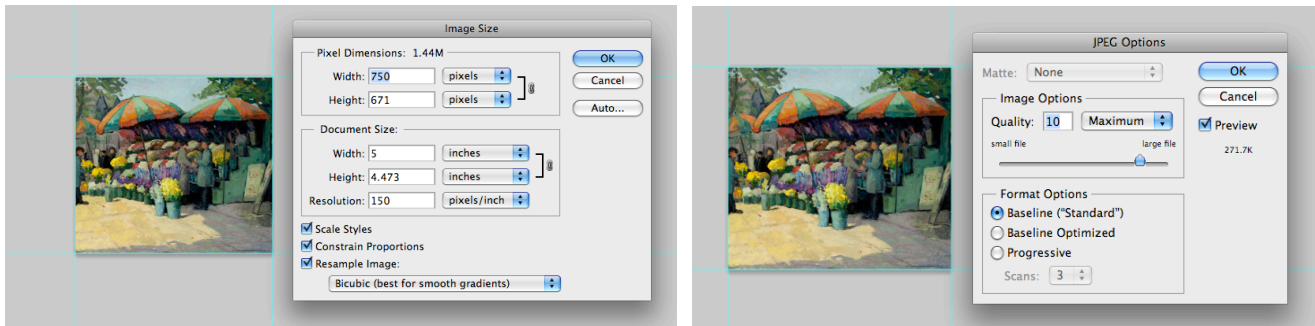
Set brightness on your monitor to see all steps from black to white

- **Image size:** Using an image-editing program, such as **Adobe Elements™** resize your digital file to 750 Pixels (5 inches) **width** for the longest side of horizontal artwork or 750 Pixels (5 inches) **height** for vertical artwork
- **150 dpi Resolution** (dpi stands for dots per inch and is interchangeable in most cases with pixels per inch)
- **Title the Image files** with your last name and 1 (*for left*) 2 (*middle*) or 3 (*right*) – this lets the facilitator know what sequence to place your images. (*Not on the image itself*)

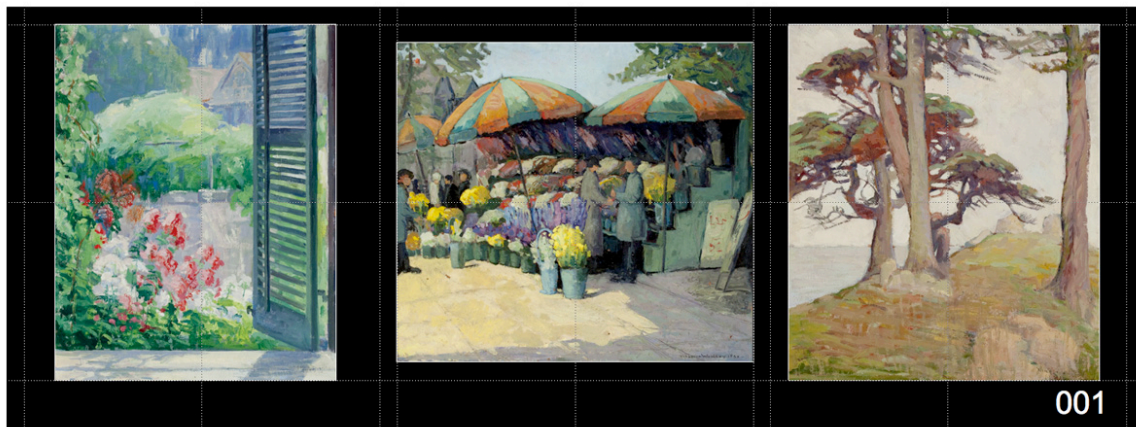

- **Save** in the JPEG format with a color setting of RGB at compression 8.
- **Burn** the three separate images to a CD, label the CD with your name and medium and submit with your application (*use separate applications and CD for each medium*).

*Once your application is processed at the Festival, your application is given a number and your image files are put sequentially into a digital presentation, all three images are projected simultaneously to the full jury.*
